



Australian Four Days Enduro 2007

Knighter triumphs in Australia on Metzeler 6Days Extreme.

David (Knighter) Knight, Enduro world champion and current points leader in the US GNCC, came, rode and conquered the Australian Four Days Enduro at Coffs Harbour in New South Wales

Knighter, using the mid season break in the American competition to compete in the Aussie event, added his first ever "Down Under" title to his already impressive collection. Together with Metzeler's 6Days Extreme he held his own through the seven special tests on day one. Day two was a typical Knighter day when he stormed to a 19 seconds lead and took control of the overall results. He added another 31 seconds advantage on day three, despite increasingly tough special tests and a frosty morning at the start of the day.

Further a fit and focused squad of Australian Yamaha riders, all fitted with Metzeler 6Days Extreme have recorded exceptional results at the 2007 Australian 4 Day Enduro (A4DE), capped off by a brilliant second overall placing by Chris Hollis. His team made Mrs. Alison Parker produced a dominant four-day campaign, winning easily by an amazing 13 minutes at the end of the final day the Woman class.
