



Indoor Enduro World Cup 2007/2008

Metzeler's victory at the first Indoor Enduro World Cup.

Perfect start into a new Enduro season for Metzeler 6Days Extreme.

Genova 2nd February 2008. After taking all 3 Enduro title for 3 years in a row, Metzeler 6Days Extreme added also the Indoor World Cup title to its significant trophy collection. At the first ever hold Indoor Enduro World cup with 3 rounds at Barcelona/Spain, Munich/Germany and the last race at Genova/Italy with Metzeler resulting again the number one, able to dominate all the three races.

David Knight (KTM/E3), the Enduro World Champion from 2005 + 2006 showed his true fighting spirit and took the overall victory. Taddy Blazusiak, the Erzberg Rodeo winner 2007 and KTM newest factory rider was close behind in second place. While Mika Ahola (Honda/E2), the last year Enduro World Champion made the "full house" for Metzeler perfect.

The event drew a crowd of almost 10.000 fans to conclude the three-event World Cup. Due to the popularity of the indoor events a World cup series of 5-6 events for 2008-2009 is under discussion.

The 2008 Enduro season has officially started, and Metzeler is looking forward to the first World Championship race, which will be held in Sweden (15.-16. March 2008).
