## Metzeler 6Days Extreme dominates also the Indoor Enduro World Cup

*Barcelona, Spain and Munich, Germany.* In the first ever FIM sanctioned indoor Enduro series Metzeler pilots showed an impressive performance.

In Barcelona, mighty Knighter on his KTM (Enduro World Champion E3 in 2005 and 2006 on Metzeler 6Days extreme) launched an impressive start to the FIM Indoor Enduro World Cup to take the opening round of the three-event series. Also on the 2<sup>nd</sup> position we find a well known Metzeler pilot Mika Ahola with Honda, this year Enduro World Champion E2.

This weekend was hold the second round at the Olympic Stadium Munich and the Metzeler pilots took the whole podium. David Knight could extend his lead in an attractive mix of demanding technical sections and high-speed straights. Mika Ahola finished second and Taddy Blazusiak, this year shooting star at the Erzberg Hard Enduro race in Austria showed again his great talent.

Results: 1. D. Knight 42 points, T. Blazusiak 39 points, M. Ahola 27 points

The last round will be held in Genoa, Italy at the 2. February 2008 the traditionally opening race of the new season. With 3 Metzeler pilots leading we are looking forward to start another successful Enduro year.
